  - ➤ Upcoming
    - Food booth at Gus Macker- Aug 23-24

    - Allegan Event Center (after marching season 2025). We would receive 20% of all sales generated by Otsego Bands, when we have 20+ signed up. The combo ticket (allowing all activities) is \$35.50. That would give us roughly \$7 per combo ticket sold. They also have tickets for specific activities that cost less. A good date for this may be December 11th or 18th (must be on a Thursday).

- ▶ Band camp recap- meet & greet, senior breakfast, water jugs, cookout
- ➤ Gus Macker menu- eliminate candy and brats
- ➤ Chris Creviston (1986 OHS grad, professional sax player, Arizona State Univ professor) visit planned during week of MS/HS Christmas concerts, will also hold a saxophone master class on that Wednesday in OHS auditorium for area sax players. He will play with symphonic band during their concert.
- > When to pay Florida trip money from band account? Ideally, this needs to be paid before families have paid too much, which would require reimbursement. OBB plans to make this payment after SnapRaise and OBI fundraisers are complete. Jena will reach out to travel company to confirm details.
- ➢ BOE meeting attendant suggested getting in front of parents/students earlier in elementary rather than waiting until 5th grade. Another suggestion was to promote music education opportunities in our communities. This is already done in several ways (elementary tour at Christmas, Marching Band performance for elementary schools, instrument petting zoo at elementary school, community Jazz Band Concert; maybe we need to invite BOE to watch some of these events)
- ➤ We will have an Otsego Band Booster table at the OMS open house on Monday, Aug 18, to give info, recruit parent volunteers, etc.
- ▶ Plan to have senior banners at the stadium this fall, Sonia Kling took photos of seniors 8/11. Will need to reschedule senior group photo. Sonia is available to take individual photos of non-seniors on 9/5, parents will have opportunity to order individual photos of their student.
- Opportunity to purchase Yard Signs and "Big Heads" of your band student. This is a fundraiser for the Cheerleaders this fall. Traditionally the yard signs are displayed before OBI, so the visitors to Otsego can see our support. The Big Head is a photo of your band

member that is large and on a stick so you can easily wave this at competitions and football games.
